What you need for Overdrive Media Console:

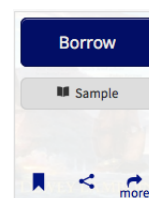
Overdrive App • Adobe ID • Library card • Wi-Fi

Directions for Android Overdrive App

1. Get free Overdrive App from Android Marketplace.
2. Get an Adobe ID: *adobe.com* > *Sign In* > *Create Account*.
3. Launch the Overdrive App and tap the three lines at the top left corner.
4. Click *Add a Library* and find your library. Type "Tellico" and tap *Search*. Choose "Ocoee River Region – Tellico Village." (Once you do this, you shouldn't have to do it again.)
5. Choose "Tennessee R.E.A.D.S."
6. Click "Sign in" at the top right of the screen.
7. If you see "[select library]," tap the down arrow and scroll down to "Tellico Village Public Library."
8. Enter your library card number and tap *Sign in*. (Be sure to check "Remember my login information on this device.")
9. Select the book you want and click it to *Borrow* (or *Place a Hold*).
10. Click *Download* and select *Adobe EPUB eBook*.
11. Click *Confirm & Download*. The book will download to Overdrive.
12. Tap the three lines at the top left corner.
13. Tap *Bookshelf*. Tap your title to begin reading or listening.



Return eBooks Early:

Tap *Bookshelf*, then tap and **hold** the book icon. Click *Return* then click *Return* again.



Renewing Your eBook:

If you do not finish your book, you have the opportunity to *renew* it three days before it expires, so long as no one has the book on hold. If that is the case, you could place it back on hold yourself and you will be notified when it is available to be renewed.

What you need for Kindle:

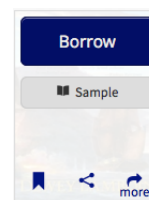
Kindle App • Amazon Account • Library Card • Wi-Fi

Directions for Android Kindle App*

1. Get Kindle App from Android Marketplace.
2. Sign into your Amazon account.
3. Download eBooks: On your Android device, go to the R.E.A.D.S. Website: <http://reads.lib.overdrive.com>.
4. Login to R.E.A.D.S.

Download Kindle eBooks:

1. Go to the R.E.A.D.S. Website: <http://reads.lib.overdrive.com>.
2. If you see “[select library],” tap the down arrow and scroll down to “Tellico Village Public Library.”
3. Enter your library card number and tap *Sign in*. (Be sure to check “Remember my login information on this device.”)
4. Select the book you want and click it to *Borrow* (or *Place a Hold*).
5. Click *Download* and select *Kindle Book*.
6. Click *Confirm & Download*. You will be automatically redirected to Amazon.
7. Login to your Amazon account. Click *Get library book*. The book will be delivered to your device over Wi-Fi.



Read your Kindle Book:

1. Kindle Books are stored in your Amazon Kindle account with other archived items. You must have Wi-Fi turned on to download library books to your Kindle.
2. Go to the *Menu* on your Kindle. Click *Sync & Check for Items*.
3. Go to *Archive d Items > Download*. The book will be downloaded to *Home*.

Return eBooks early:

1. Go to Amazon.com > *Manage Your Kindle*.
2. Choose *Return this book* from *Actions* menu.
3. Read: Open the Kindle App. Tap *Home* or *Archived Items*.
4. Return early: Go to Amazon.com > *Manage Your Kindle*. Choose *Return this book* from *Actions* menu.

*If you are unable to access Kindle Books on your smartphone, use a computer or tablet to browse and check out Kindle Books. Books will still be delivered to your mobile device over Wi-Fi.
